CAMP MEETING COMMUNIQUÉ

Welcome to Camp Meeting 2008! We know you will be inspired and drawn closer to the Lord. The following is an assortment of things you should know: rules, regulations, and registration information for both this year and the next.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of everyone, we ask that you abide by the rules and regulations of Camp Meeting and uphold the standards of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Those who do not abide by the rules *will be asked to leave the campground.*

1. **DOGS OR ANY OTHER PETS**, other than service companions, will **NOT** be allowed on the campground. Violators will be asked to leave.
2. **SAFETY CODES** mandated by the fire department must be enforced at all times. No unauthorized vehicle will be allowed to park in the restricted zones.
3. **MINORS** under age 21 will not be allowed lodging at any time unless accompanied by responsible adults.
4. **QUIET TIME** is expected between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Please be considerate of your neighbors.
5. **RADIOS OR TAPE RECORDERS** should be played only if they can be listened to by private earphones. Your neighbor is just a canvas away!
6. **SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, AND ROLLERBLADES** are **PROHIBITED** on campus.
7. **BICYCLES** are allowed on campus. However, per Florida law, all riders under age 16 **MUST WEAR** a bike helmet. Those without helmets will be asked to not ride their bikes.
8. **NO CAMP FIRES** are allowed at all, at any time. No exceptions.
9. **NO OPEN FLAMES** of any kind are permitted inside any tents. This means candles, lanterns, cook stoves, etc. All cooking must be done in the designated cooking area.
10. **PARKING** is permitted only in designated areas. Cars parked in unauthorized areas may be towed at the owners expense.
11. **FOR YOUR CHILDREN'S SAFETY**, always have an adult accompany them to their various meeting locations and activities. The Camp Meeting facility **IS** an open campus.
12. **ALL CAMPERS AND RVs** must be removed from the campground by Monday, May 26. Campers may not be stored on our facility.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

(For Actual and Future Use)

1. **ACCOMMODATIONS:** You have the option of securing the same room, tent, or RV spot you are presently occupying by filling out the application and turning it in by the end of Camp Meeting, along with a 50% deposit, at the Registration Office. If you don't secure it at this time, please understand the lodging will be available on a first-come, first-served basis and you may not get the same location as previous times. We thank you for your Christian understanding.
2. **CANCELLATION POLICY:** Should you need to cancel your accommodations, please call us as soon as possible. The deadline for cancellations is one week prior to Camp Meeting. After this time, your deposit will be forfeited.
3. **ANTICIPATED DATE OF ARRIVAL:** If you don't show up by your anticipated date of arrival, please understand your space may be given to someone else.
4. **EARLY CHECK-INS:** We cannot accommodate any requests for early check-ins or camping set-ups. The campground is not ready for occupancy until the Friday Camp Meeting begins.
5. **CHECK-OUT:** Check-out is no later than 10 a.m. on Monday, May 26.
