Hi Friend,

I'm writing to you today to offer you a great opportunity. Dr Scott Turansky and Joanne Miller, RN, BSN from the *National Center for Biblical Parenting* teach parenting seminars in churches all around the country. They help churches do outreach and equip parents with tools to address the hearts of their kids.

We'll be teaching in Orlando on Saturday, March 24, 2012. We're looking for another church or two who might be interested in hosting a parenting seminar on Thursday or Friday evenings, March 22 or 23. *We're offering a special deal for these two dates.* If you book a seminar on one of these dates, we've chosen to waive the travel cost.

The seminar we'd teach in an evening event would be different from the Saturday seminar. We can teach on *anger* and *bad attitudes* or on *relationships in the family*. Children and their parents often struggle with emotions and relationships. We want to equip parents with practical, biblical tools to help their kids. This material is energizing and hopeful. It requires about two and a half hours, making it just the right length for an evening event at your church.

Dr. Scott Turansky and Joanne Miller have teamed up to write eight parenting books and are committed to helping churches train and equip parents to be more effective with their children.

They conduct over 40 live Parenting Seminar Outreaches a year. Parents go away with hands on ideas but much more than that. Our seminar is a spiritual experience, even for nonbelievers. Turansky and Miller teach parenting seminars with outreach in mind and use a heart-based approach, grounded in the scripture, with practical application to families.

Our favorite way to teach is as an outreach to the community. We've also written children's program material that complements what the parents are learning. It's great to see families growing together. We'll give you a flier original, posters, and DVD commercials you can use in your worship service to advertise the event. We also have follow up material so that you can make this more than just a one-time event, but a lasting relationship with the people who attend. This is a great way to help families and do outreach at the same time.
